



Fold in the flap and glue with leather glue before stitching. This creates a nice finish where the boot meets the shifter knob.

Stitch back side piece along red dashes.

Stitch front side piece along red dashes.

Stitch the leather together with the nice side facing in. Once all four sides have been stitched together, run an additional set down each side of first stitch to secure excess leather material within the boot and to create the double stitch effect. Note: This will get all four pieces stitched together, but one side of the boot will need to be stitched, and it's going to be difficult to double stitch it without a proper sewing machine. So I recommend making sure you face that last stitch towards the front of the Jeep and out of view... with one stitch to finish the project. Now turn inside out and place on shifter.
